



2017 MAJESTIQUE
LE CHATELET VINEYARD
SAINT EMILION GRAND CRU CLASSE

Our twelfth vintage from this amazing right bank vineyard. The vintage saw a shorter growing season than usual but the resultant wines are extremely well balanced. The aromatics boast dark red Bing cherry with dry herbs, cardamom and spice. The Cabernet franc is surprisingly dominant on the nose. The wine has a more savory profile as opposed to sweet, with amazing minerality, earthiness and the structure demonstrating purity and focus. The tannins are sublime and elegant. A very traditional Bordeaux worthy of long cellaring. Decanting suggested.
