What a fun vintage for a French winemaker – back to the tradition of low alcohol and finesse. It felt like we were in Bordeaux and not California. This wine's blend composition is a reflection of the vintage. Having selected out all Cabernet that did not meet our standards, the resultant wine is a round, sumptuous wine with silky tannins and notes of black currant fruit, tobacco, mocha, and cedar that combine with a long and lingering finish. This Cabernet is lush, delicious and loaded with character.
