MONTBLEAU VINEYARD
NAPA VALLEY

This two acre, west facing, hillside vineyard is situated in the Glass Mountain district in the appellation of St. Helena and is adjacent to the future Melka Winery. The aromatics exhibit ripe, baked strawberries, dried flowers and wet crushed rocks. Affectionately referred to as “Force Tranquil” by Philippe, this seductive wine boasts incredible amplitude, minerality with good acidity and freshness in the finish. The tannins are reminiscent of left bank classic Bordeaux and demonstrate what old vines are capable of producing. Recommended to decant.
